Status of Class Year 2021, Class Year 2023 and Expedited Deliverability Study 2023-01

o Class Year 2021 (CY21)

- CY21 Additional SDU Studies approved by OC on March 21, 2023.
- On March 21, 2023 the NYISO sent a notice of initial decision period to CY21 Additional SDU study projects. Each CY21 ASDU project developer was required to provide their decision to the NYISO on or before April 20, 2023.
- On April 21, 2023 the NYISO sent a notice of initial decision period results for CY21 Additional SDU study projects. As non-acceptance events occurred in the initial decision period for CY21 ASDU Study, a subsequent decision period was required. The NYISO will issue a revised CY21 ASDU study report by May 5, 2023.

o Class Year 2023 (CY23)

- CY23 officially started on February 13, 2023.
 - The NYISO received over 100 notices of intent to join CY23.
 - After reviewing the eligibility of each request, NYISO tendered FSAs to all eligible CY23 members in mid-February, triggering the requirement that Developers submit completed FSA forms, required data and deposits.
 - The NYISO has finished validating all 84 projects' FSA data for CY23. All CY23 projects' FSAs are fully executed.
 - CY23 participant list will be released on May 5, 2023.
 - CY23 ATBA Base Case series is still under development.
 - The NYISO will use the UCDF methodology approved by FERC on April 11 with an effective date of February 13, 2023. That methodology clarified the derating methodology to reflect recent changes to UCAP calculations for resource types, including Capacity Accreditation Factors. Under the revised methodology, the UCDF for all generators that are not Intermittent Power Resources or Limited Control Run of River Hydro will be the average EFORd. For Intermittent Power Resources and Limited Control Run of River Hydro, rather than being calculated solely based on resource type, the UCDF will be calculated based on historical production data by the resource type in accordance with the ISO Procedures.

Expedited Deliverability Studies (EDS)

- The EDS study (EDS 2023-01) started on February 24, 2023.
 - The NYISO received over 15 requests to join EDS 2023-1.

Status of Class Year 2021, Class Year 2023 and Expedited Deliverability Study 2023-01

- After reviewing the eligibility of each request, NYISO tendered EDS agreements to developers in March.
- The NYISO is in the process of confirming all data provided is sufficient and, upon confirmation, tendering execution versions of EDS agreement.
