# Completed

- **Presented at the December 3, 2018 IPPTF**
  - Augmenting the Brattle Analysis with year 2022 analysis
  - Considering the effects of carbon pricing on repowering and on retention
  - Considering consequences of AC transmission project

# Analysis Requests

- **Consider consequences of no carbon pricing, including estimates of the costs of various buyer side mitigation scenarios**
  - The NYISO has considered how it might structure such an analysis and will not be performing this analysis at this time

# Analysis Requests (Cont.)

- **Consider the benefits of carbon pricing impacts without CES and/or non-achievement of the 50% by 2030 renewable goal**
  - The NYISO believes that the analysis presented to date is informative to the questions that this type of analysis would be trying to answer
  - The NYISO will not be performing this analysis
