

### **Lesson Learned Process**

- NYISO previously conducted lessons learned sessions with stakeholders following the selection of projects to address the Western NY and AC Transmission Needs
- The resulting improvements, among others, were used in the Long Island Offshore Wind Export PPTN evaluation and selection process



# Process Improvements Used in the Long Island PPTN

- Conducted a technical conference before soliciting proposed solutions to discuss baseline assessment, Viability & Sufficiency criteria, and evaluation metrics
- Eliminated the pause point for NYPSC confirmation of a transmission need
- Implemented cost containment measures
- Mechanism to implement Transmission Owners' ROFR over Public Policy Transmission Upgrades
- Better alignment between the public policy and interconnection processes



### **Process Improvements Going Forward**

- Based on feedback from prior meetings, NYISO is considering:
  - Revisions to Data Submission forms for Public Policy Transmission Projects
  - Improvements in post-selection coordination (e.g., milestone tracking, reviewing modifications, and stakeholder updates)
  - Provide more system information prior to solicitation
- NYISO is seeking stakeholder suggestions on areas for improvement, including specific proposals



# Consideration of Process Improvements for Implementation

- NYISO will consider not only process improvements but prioritize those improvements based on the steps that are necessary to adopt them
- Process improvements that can be implemented in time for the NYC PPTN will be prioritized, while other improvements that cannot be implemented in the near future will be tracked for future implementation
