# **Objective**

- The NYISO would like to remind all ICAP Suppliers in a Mitigated Capacity Zone of the on-going obligation to update their list of Affiliated Entities in the NYISO's ICAP Automated Market System (AMS).
  - This obligation to report and manage MP Affiliate Information is separate and distinct from both Stakeholder Services' and Member Relations' Affiliate reporting requirements.



# Background



## **Supply Side Mitigation Measures**

#### Physical withholding provision

 Specific provision on audit of decisions to retire, remove, or de-rate capacity

#### Pivotal Supplier measures

- Subject to offer cap (greater of UCAP Offer Reference Level and Going-Forward Costs, if a GFC determination was made)
- "Must offer" requirement for Mitigated UCAP (UCAP subject to control by a Pivotal Supplier)



## **Pivotal Suppliers**

- Each month, at the close of the certification period, the NYISO will determine if a Market Party and its Affiliated Entities (together, a "portfolio") are Pivotal Suppliers
  - At least some portion of the suppliers' resources under common control are needed to meet the UCAP requirement in the Mitigated Capacity Zone
    - Control, generally, is by contract or an ownership interest

## **Designation of Affiliated Entities**

- Market Parties that own or have "control" of capacity in a MCZ are required to identify their "Affiliated Entities", based on the criteria in the Market Services Tariff, Attachment H, Section 23.2.1
  - MW of all capacity Resources are counted in the portfolio
  - Control may be rebutted
    - Generally, it can be rebutted with a showing that control has been shifted
  - The ICAP Event Calendar specifies the deadlines for identifying Affiliated Entities



# MP Obligation



## **MP Obligation**

- Each Market Participant is required to identify each of its Affiliated Entities
  - See MST Section 5.12.1
- Reporting/updating is done through the ICAP Automated Market System
- Deadlines are posted on the ICAP Event Calendar

### **MP Affiliate Form**



#### **Process**

- In the ICAP AMS, the Market Participant can select or deselect affiliates.
- The Market Participant defines the dates the Affiliate relationship is in effect and the AMS associates that Affiliate relationship for the effective ICAP Spot Auction Months that the relationship is Active.
- If an Affiliate relationship (affiliate organizations/entities) has not changed from the information that was reported for the previous period, then no changes to those previous entries are required.
- If more than one type of Affiliated Entity description describes the relationship, select the relationship that best describes situation. (The AMS provides for the selection of only one description.)



#### **Process**

- If an Affiliated Entity is not in the Affiliated Entity AMS drop down list
  - The Market Participant must initiate a formal request to Stakeholder and Member Services (SMS) to have a new Affiliated Entity
    Organization added to the Affiliated Entity List.
  - The deadline to submit this formal request is identified in the ICAP Event Calendar
