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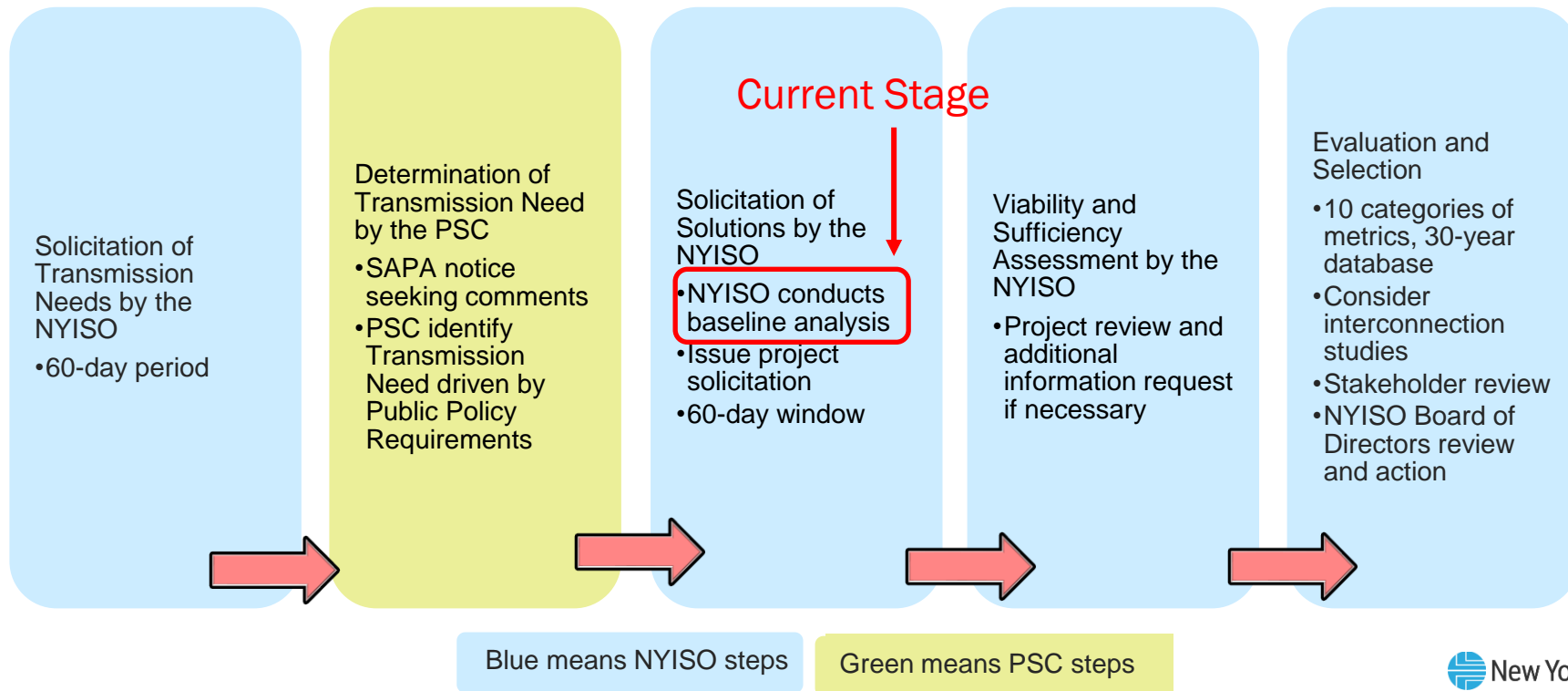

Developer Qualification Process

- Developers must be qualified under Attachment Y to be eligible to propose a Public Policy Transmission Project for the NYC PPTN and to be eligible to use the cost allocation and cost recovery mechanism for regulated transmission projects
- Developers qualified under the Reliability Planning Process or Economic Planning Process at the time of the NYISO solicitation for solutions in the Public Policy Process are similarly qualified to submit a proposed Public Policy Transmission Project to the NYC PPTN
- A Developer shall retain its qualification status for a three-year period following the notification date, unless such qualification is revoked due to a material change in the Developer's qualifications

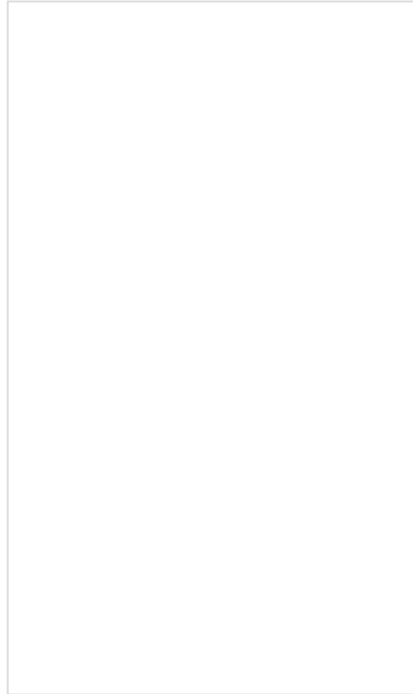
