1. Administrative Matters and Chair's Report

Mr. Ryan Coalla (Central Hudson) called the meeting to order at 9:05 AM and welcomed the members of CDAS as roll call was taken. The meeting minutes from August 2023 were approved.

2. ICCP Updates

3. Providing NYISO Contingency Analysis Results for TOs

Mr. Steve Singer (NYISO) stated that the NYISO had concluded the project with opening up the files to all transmission owners for download, in addition the Transmission Owners have also been trained in the NYISO SOTS training program.

4. Central Hudson EMS Status Report

Mr. Ryan Coalla (Central Hudson) stated that they are proceeding on schedule. Testing is expected in the coming months.

5. TO Substation/Router Replacement

Mr. Tanvir Khan (NYISO) reported that for the Substation Router Upgrade, as of last month's CDAS update, we had work remaining on 4 substations - 2 for Con Edison, 2 for National Grid.

- We completed cutover of both National Grid substations - Clay and Scriba.
- For Con Edison's 2 remaining substations - Sprainbrook and East Fishkill - we found a configuration issue that we are now reviewing. NYISO will ship the routers back out soon and will coordinate with the Con Edison team to schedule both cutovers.

Mr. Ryan Coalla (Central Hudson) stated A few of the TOs are trying to get together and do some TSM training. He noted that anyone interested in attending to please reach out.
