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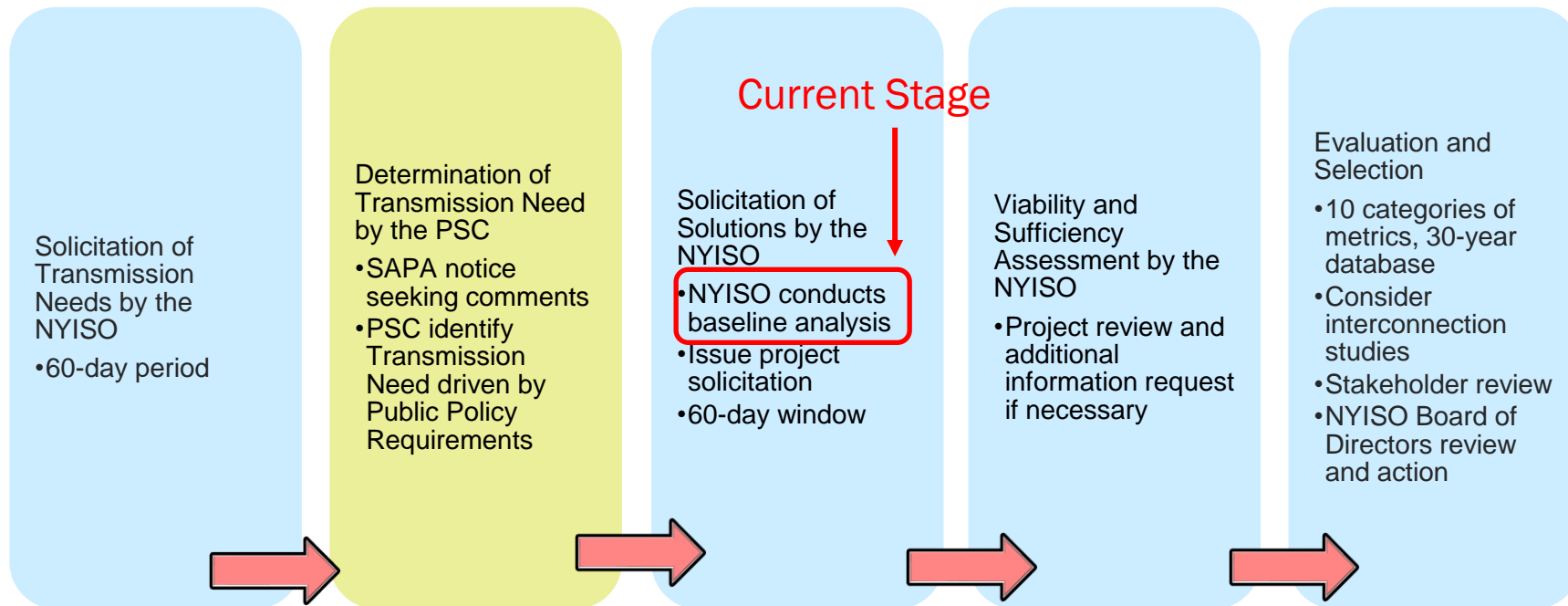

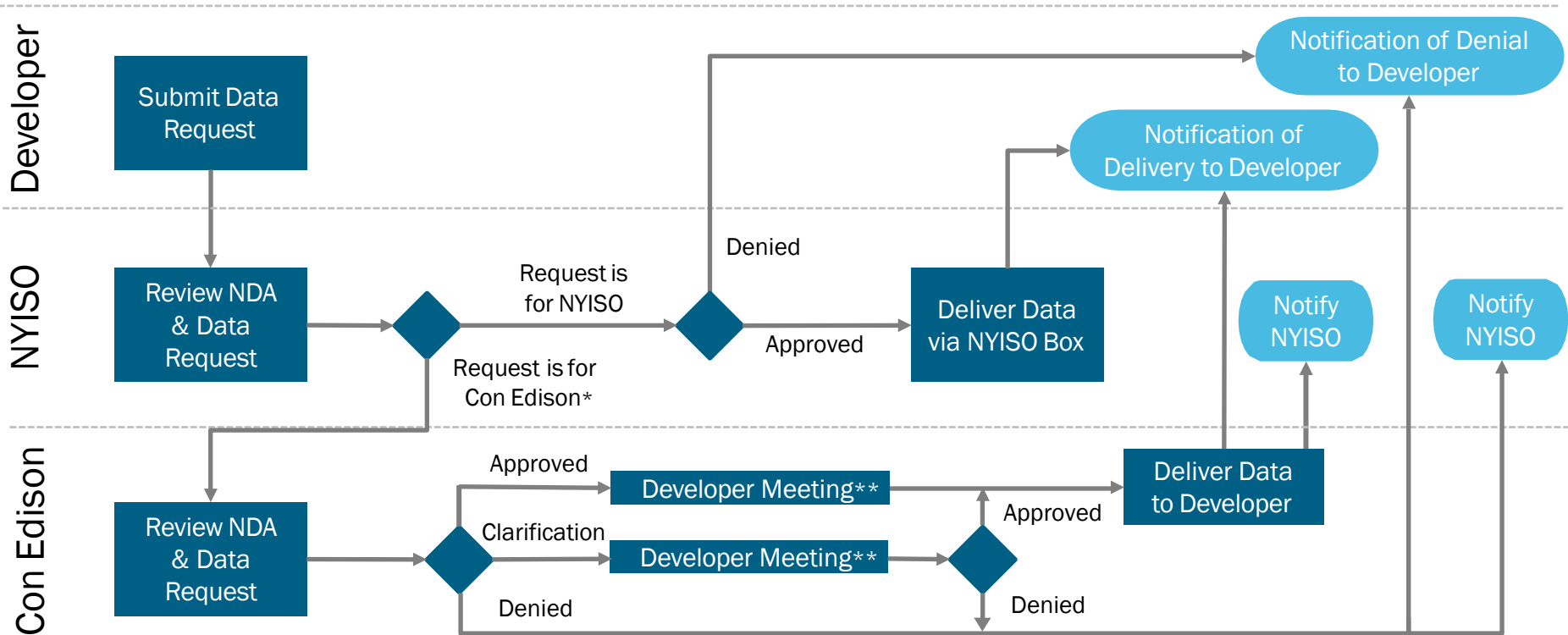

**Without an executed Con Edison NDA, requestors can request information but will be limited to visually reviewing CEII information through an in-person visit at Con Edison's corporate office (4 Irving Place, New York, NY)*

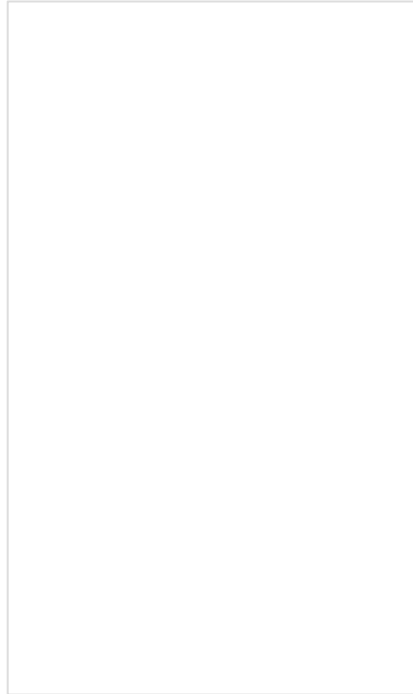

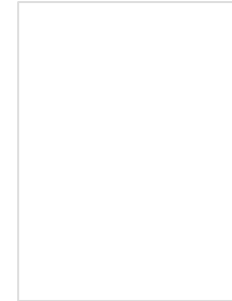
