1. Administrative Matters

Ms. Corinne Didomenico (NextEra, ESPWG Chair) called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

2. Chair's report

Ms. Didomenico said that she did not receive any correspondence from the Operating Committee (OC).

3. Status of NYISO Studies/Activities

Ms. Wenjin Yan (NYISO) reviewed the document included with the meeting material.

In response to a question, Ms. Yan said the NYISO made an adjustment to its schedule because the ATRA case was not finalized until September 2023, so the deliverability study component was revised. The NYISO is still targeting August/September 2024 for stakeholder review of the Class Year 23 study.

In response to a question, Ms. Yan said the next EDS study would commence after 30 days once OC approves the current EDS study.

4. New Business

Mr. Timothy Duffy (NYISO) reviewed the presentation included with the meeting material.

In response to a question, Mr. Scott Simon (Con Edison) said Con Edison is observing growth beyond 2024 for its long term forecast. Mr. Duffy added that the NYISO was currently in the process of developing the long term forecasts and working with the Transmission Owners as well as the Load Forecasting Task Force. Those forecasts will be captured in the 2024 Gold Book, which will be developed in Q1 2024.

In response to a question, Mr. Duffy said the longer term forecast would be discussed in March 2024 with stakeholders.

In response to a question, Ms. Sara Keegan (NYISO) said there would not be a Class Year 2024 and the NYISO would seek to begin the cluster study when it files its compliance proposal with FERC. The NYISO would still accept interconnection requests and developers can obtain feasibility studies, which may provide benefit to developers as they enter a cluster study and to help validate their application. The NYISO would discuss further at IITF on January 11, 2024.
