1. Administrative Matters and Chair's Report

Mr. Greg Sacco (NYPA) called the meeting to order at 9:05 AM and welcomed the members of CDAS as roll call was taken.

2. PMU Data Quality

Mr. Steve Graber (NYISO) reported that he was working on a project to improve the PMU data quality across New York State because there have been various issues. He reached out to the Transmission Owners to help him in the effort and appreciated the cooperation of the TOs in the effort.

3. NYISO Telemetry Hardware Upgrade

Mr. Tanvir Khan (NYISO) reported that the NYISO kicked off a project to replace the RFL phase one telemetry hardware. The goal for this year is do a proof of concepts of different hardware setups, and depending on the proof of concept analysis, the NYISO plans to purchase the replacement hardware in Q3 2024. Once the hardware gets purchased, the NYISO plans to begin replacing the core infrastructure and equipment on the NYISO's end and also potentially a couple of devices in the field by end of year. The field replacement work would continue in 2025 and be completed by 2026. The NYISO would provide updates to CDAS going forward.

In response to a question, Mr. Mike Cirella (NYISO) said the NYISO did not have a list of scheduled substations at this time, but all substations with phase one equipment would be upgraded.
