Public Policy Transmission Planning Process Update

- NYISO will initiate its 2024-2025 planning cycle for the Public Policy Transmission Planning Process
- Pursuant to Section 31.4.2 of Attachment Y to the NYISO Open Access Transmission Tariff (“OATT”), any stakeholder or interested party may submit proposed transmission needs that it believes are being driven by Public Policy Requirements and for which NYISO should solicit and evaluate transmission solutions

NYC PPTN Next Steps

- NYISO will post notice of extension of and an estimated completion date for the 2022-2023 cycle that includes the NYC PPTN
- NYISO will publish an initial facility characterization list at least 30 calendar days prior to presentation of initial draft of Viability and Sufficiency Assessment in accordance with Section 31.4.6.5.1.1 of Attachment Y
- Subject to the requestor's compliance with NYISO's requirements concerning the disclosure of CELL, redacted proposals will be made available to requestors at least 30 calendar days prior to presentation of initial draft of Viability and Sufficiency Assessment in accordance with Section 31.4.4.3.11 of Attachment Y

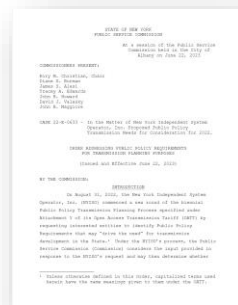
