Redacted Proposals

- The Public Policy Transmission Planning Process requires the NYISO to make redacted proposals available to requestors at least 30 calendar days prior to presentation of initial draft of Viability and Sufficiency Assessment (VSA) subject to the requestor's compliance with the NYISO's requirements concerning the disclosure of CEI
- Redacted proposals were made available on September 20, 2024 to eligible requestors
- For entities still seeking to request the redacted proposals, see "Supplemental Information" attached to this presentation for instructions on how to request

Facility Characterization

- The Public Policy Transmission Planning Process requires the NYISO to post an initial facility characterization list at least 30 calendar days prior to presentation of initial draft of VSA in accordance with Section 31.4.6.5.1.1 of Attachment Y
- Initial facility characterization list was posted to NYISO's website ([link](#)) on September 20, 2024
