<sup>2</sup> On November 20, 2019, the NYISO's Management Committee recommended that the NYISO Board of Directors direct the NYISO to file with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission enhancements to the Competitive Entry Exemption provisions found in Section 23.4.5.7 of the Services Tariff. Should the Commission accept this filing with sufficient time remaining in Class Year 2019, the NYISO will provide a notice to all Class Year 2019 members that specifies a time period where members of Class Year 2019 that have not requested an exemption will be able to request a Competitive Entry Exemption. The NYISO shall update the list as necessary.
